TODAY'S SURVEY BY A-B-C NEWS AND THE WASHINGTON POST SAYS 65-PERCENT OF THE PUBLIC SUPPORTS STRONGER FEDERAL REGULATIONS ON THE WAY FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS DO BUSINESS... 31 PERCENT DISAGREED.

WHEN IT COMES TO BAILOUTS, MORE THAN HALF OF THOSE QUESTIONED PREFERRED PUTTING MONEY IN A FUND TO COVER THE COST OF TAKING OVER AND BREAKING UP LARGE FIRMS FACING POSSIBLE COLLAPSE.

THE NEW POLL ALSO SAYS JUST 48 PERCENT APPROVE OF HOW PRESIDENT OBAMA HAS HANDLED WALL STREET AND BIG BANKS, YET THEY THINK HE WOULD DO A BETTER JOB CRACKING DOWN THAN THE REPUBLICANS.
